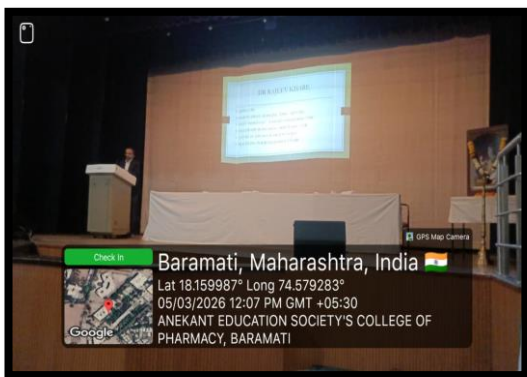

## **CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION (CPR) HANDS ON TRAINING**

**Date: 05/03/2026**

The Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) Training Session was successfully organized on 05th March 2026 at 03:30 PM at AESCOP, First Floor, Classroom No. 204 under the Co-Curricular Activity Cell for Diploma in Pharmacy students. The session was conducted by Mr. Somnath Mahajan, a Business Executive from USV Pvt. Ltd. and was efficiently coordinated by Prof. Anand Vitthaldas. The program witnessed the participation of 72 students along with 7 faculty members, making it a well-attended and engaging session. The primary objective of the training was to impart essential knowledge and practical skills related to Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation, which is a crucial life-saving technique used in emergency situations such as cardiac arrest.

During the session, the trainer elaborated on the importance of immediate response in critical situations and explained the fundamental principles of CPR in a clear and systematic manner. The training included both theoretical explanation and practical demonstration of CPR techniques, such as proper hand positioning, chest compressions, rescue breathing, and maintaining the correct rhythm during resuscitation. Students were also made aware of how to assess an emergency situation, check responsiveness, and take appropriate action until professional medical help arrives. The session emphasized the significance of timely intervention and how prompt CPR can significantly increase the chances of survival in patients experiencing cardiac arrest.

The presence of Dr. Rajiv Khare added great value to the session, as he shared his clinical expertise and real-life experiences related to cardiac emergencies. He highlighted the importance of CPR in saving lives and encouraged students to develop confidence in handling such situations. His guidance provided deeper insight into the medical relevance of CPR and motivated students to take the training seriously.

The session was highly interactive, with students actively participating in the demonstrations and showing keen interest in learning the techniques. The hands-on approach helped them understand the procedure more effectively and boosted their confidence in performing CPR. The activity proved to be highly informative, practical, and beneficial for the students, as it enhanced their knowledge, awareness, and preparedness to respond to emergency situations. Overall, the CPR training session was a successful initiative that contributed significantly to the development of essential healthcare skills among the participants and reinforced the importance of life-saving interventions in the field of pharmacy and healthcare.

## MAHADEVLAL SHROFF JAYANTI

Date- 06/03/2026

The birth anniversary of Mahadeva Lal Schroff is celebrated every year to honor his pioneering contribution to the development and advancement of pharmacy education in India. He is widely recognized as the *Father of Pharmacy Education in India* because of his visionary efforts to establish pharmacy as a distinct professional discipline within the healthcare system.

During the early 20th century, pharmacy education in India was not well structured, and the profession lacked a formal academic framework. Recognizing the need for scientific training in pharmaceutical sciences, Dr. Mahadeva Lal Schroff introduced systematic and professional pharmacy education in the country. In 1937, he initiated the first university-level pharmacy course at Banaras Hindu University, which marked a historic milestone in the evolution of pharmaceutical education in India. His efforts laid the foundation for modern pharmacy curricula and inspired the establishment of pharmacy institutions across the nation.

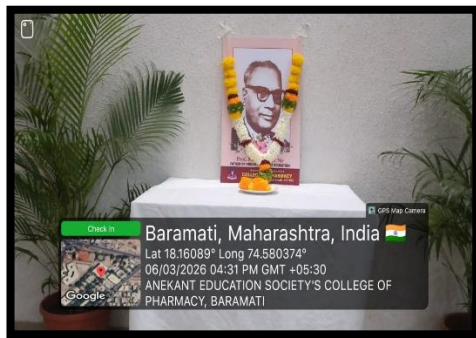

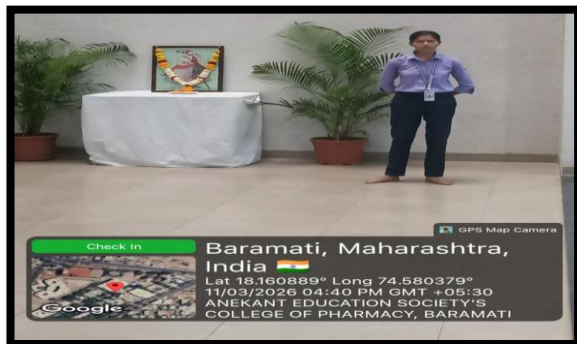
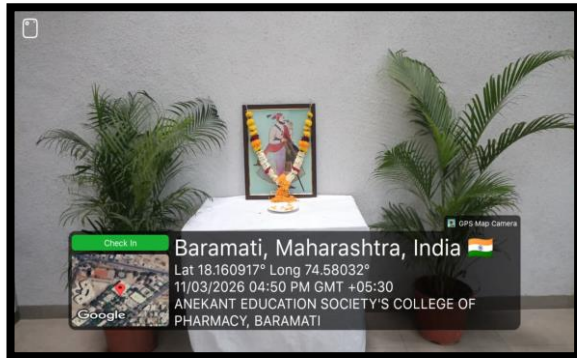
