PHARMACY FOUNDATION COURSE

Date- 09/09/ 2025

A ten-day Pharmacy Basic Foundation Course was organized at *Anekant Education Society's College of Pharmacy, Baramati* from 9th September 2025 to 19th September 2025 for candidates interested in pursuing pharmacy education. The program was designed to provide a comprehensive introduction to the profession of pharmacy, its multidisciplinary subjects, and the various facilities available within the college campus.

During the course, participants were introduced to all major pharmacy subjects including Pharmaceutics, Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Pharmacology, Pharmacognosy, Human Anatomy and Physiology, Pharmaceutical Analysis, and Biochemistry. Both theoretical sessions and practical demonstrations were conducted to help students gain a clear understanding of the fundamentals of pharmacy. Laboratory sessions included exposure to essential instruments such as the pH meter, colorimeter, tablet punching machine, capsule filling machine, and dissolution testers. Participants also visited the Machine Room where they observed large-scale pharmaceutical manufacturing equipment and processes.

A special highlight of the program was the Model Pharmacy Demonstration, where students learned about prescription handling, drug storage, labeling, patient counseling, and dispensing practices. To emphasize the importance of natural medicine, a visit to the Herbal Garden was arranged, where participants studied the cultivation, identification,

and significance of medicinal plants. Along with academic and laboratory exposure, students were oriented with the campus facilities through a guided tour of classrooms, laboratories, library, computer lab, and research areas.

To ensure cultural and extracurricular exposure, participants were taken to Jivraj Hall and the Cultural Stadium, which highlighted the institution's commitment to holistic student development. An information session on the history of the college, available courses, faculty expertise, and support systems further enhanced their understanding of the academic environment.

Another important component of the program was the Library Orientation. Students were introduced to the well-equipped college library, which houses textbooks, reference books, journals, e-resources, and digital facilities. They were guided on how to access study material, use online databases, and explore research resources, thereby enhancing their awareness of academic support systems available for pharmacy education.

Overall, the Pharmacy Basic Foundation Course provided a well-balanced blend of theory, practical knowledge, demonstrations, visits, and cultural orientation, helping participants develop confidence and clarity about the scope and importance of pharmacy. The course proved to be an enriching experience and successfully laid a strong foundation for students aspiring to build their future in the pharmacy profession.

A FIELD VISIT TO LATE MANIKABAI SARAF BLOOD BANK

Date- 13/09/ 2025

On 13th September 2025, *Anekant Education Society's College of Pharmacy, Baramati* organized an academic field visit to Late Manikabai Saraf Blood Bank, Baramati to provide students with practical exposure beyond classroom learning. The visit offered an in-depth understanding of how a modern blood bank functions as a vital link in the healthcare system. Students observed the entire process, beginning with donor registration and medical examination, followed by blood collection, labeling, and safe storage under prescribed conditions.

The experts at the blood bank explained the advanced techniques used for separation of blood components such as plasma, platelets, and packed red cells, and highlighted the significance of component therapy in ensuring effective patient treatment. They also demonstrated the stringent quality control and screening procedures adopted to detect infections and ensure compatibility before transfusion. In addition, the session emphasized the importance of voluntary blood donation, awareness among youth, and the ethical responsibility of pharmacy professionals in promoting safe donation practices. The visit proved highly beneficial as it enhanced the students' knowledge of transfusion medicine, familiarized them with regulatory guidelines, and motivated them to appreciate the humanitarian value of blood donation in saving lives.

Date- 13/09/2025

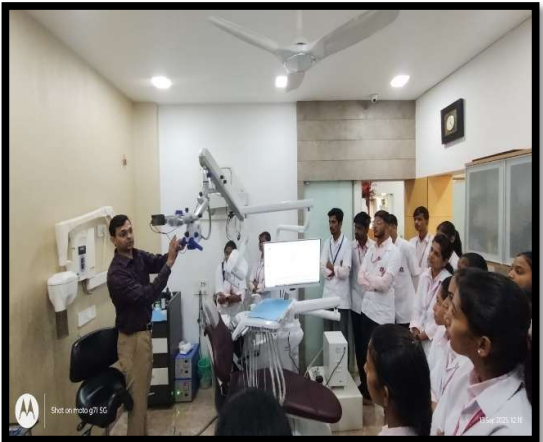
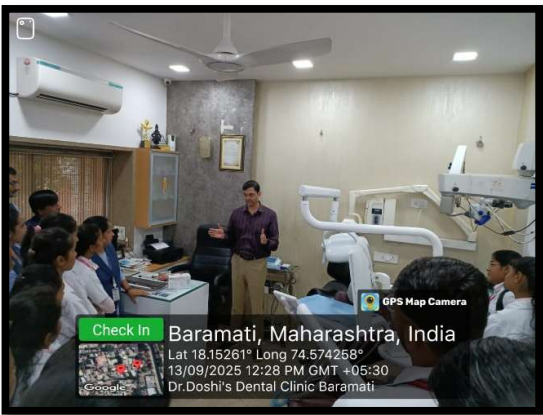

HEALTH & MEDICATION AWARENESS RALLY

Date - 27/09/ 2025

On 27th September 2025, *Anekant Education Society's College of Pharmacy, Baramati (AESCOP)* organized a Medication Awareness Rally as part of the ongoing Pharmacovigilance Week celebrations.

The rally commenced in the morning from the college campus and proceeded along a designated route covering Bhigwan Chowk, Gunawadi Chowk, and returned back to the college.
